Lane closures scheduled for I-80 in Solano County

Solano County - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) today announced five nights of closures scheduled next week for **VARIOUS** lanes of westbound and eastbound Interstate 80. Sections of I-80 that will be impacted are between the Airbase Parkway exit in Fairfield and East of Leisure Town Road in Vacaville.

The closures will begin on the night of Sunday, December 7 and run through the morning of Thursday, December 11. Lane closures in the westbound direction will be from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Eastbound, the closures will run from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Closures of some ramps between the two limits are also scheduled during this period. On and off ramps that will be affected are at Mason, Alamo and Davis Streets in Vacaville.

During the closures, crews will place paving notches on the roadway, fix approach slabs and make adjustments to Thrie Beam Barriers in the eastbound direction. This segment of I-80 work is scheduled for completion by August 2009.

Caltrans is rehabilitating 27 miles of pavement on Interstate 80 from Tennessee Street in Vallejo to Leisure Town in Vacaville.

The segment of work between Tennessee Street and American Canyon Road will be completed by the end of December, 2008. Work on other segments of I-80 in Solano County, including the HOV lanes from Red Top Road to Air Base Parkway, will continue through the summer of 2010.

The results will be a much smoother, quieter ride for about 150,000 motorists who use this vital roadway every day. These projects will address the pavement conditions, congestion and will enhance safety and operations. More information on the projects is available online at www.Pave80.com.
